

# What is Anticoagulant Treatment?

## Additional Information from the Anticoagulation Nurses

### Things to Do

- Always hand over the bottom slip from your dosing letter with every blood test.
- A new dosing letter will then be sent to your home address within three working days. If not received within three working days please telephone anticoagulant clinic for another copy.
- Until dosing letter received, please continue with your current dose of anticoagulant.

### Things Not to Do

- **Don't** have INR blood test on Fridays, Weekends or Bank Holidays.
- **Don't** run out of anticoagulant tablets. Obtain repeat prescriptions from your GP, it may take a few days to obtain your prescription.
- **Don't** take non-steroidal anti inflammatory drugs such as Neurofen, Brufen or Ibuprofen. Any medication brought over the counter should be checked with pharmacist to ensure it is safe to take with anticoagulant treatment.
- **Don't** take herbal products with anticoagulant medication.
- **Don't** drink cranberry juice or green tea.
- **Don't** eat any of the following vegetables more than 3 times per week:  
broccoli, spinach, watercress, cabbage, brussel sprouts, rocket, kale and swiss chard leaf.
- **Don't** take more than a small amount of alcohol i.e. 2 units for women and 3 units for men per day

1 unit = 1 glass of wine (small)  
or  
1 pub measure of spirits  
or  
½ pint beer
